What exactly is Transition Year?

Transition Year is a one-year programme that bridges the gap between the Junior and Senior Cycles.

It's so much more than just an extra year in school.

It's a year of exploration, growth, and preparation - a bridge that helps students transition from adolescence to young adulthood and from the Junior Cycle to the Senior Cycle.

Overview of the TY Programme



- Our school's Transition Year (TY) program is all about helping the student grow as a person.
- It give students chances to learn in fun and meaningful ways
- The programme helps students discover the different paths they could take in the future
- The TY programme will evolve continuously to support the learning and development of the student
- Students and Parents are invited to have an input into the programme

Benefits of the TY Programme



- TY offers students the opportunity to try out a range of new experiences and develop new skills through a variety of modules that they would not be able to experience in 5th year..
- The TY programme offers a wide range of of workshops/initiatives
- It gives students the chance to develop new hobbies and skills that they can take with them long after they leave school. Of course, all these activities give students the opportunity to mix with new people and meet new friends. A lot of the activities focus on teamwork and friendship.

A year to mature



- Many students who proceed straight into 5th year will find themselves being 17 when they are looking to embark on college life.
- TY offers young people the chance to mature and develop which will in turn help them to navigate the transition to senior cycle easier.
- College dropout rates are higher in less mature students. The extra year of maturity TY offers can not only help them make the right college choices but also settle into college much easier when they go.
- Students in TY have a distinct advantage over those who proceed directly into 5th year when it comes to gathering up experience, skills, hobbies and references for their CVs.

Erasmus - French & German Exchange

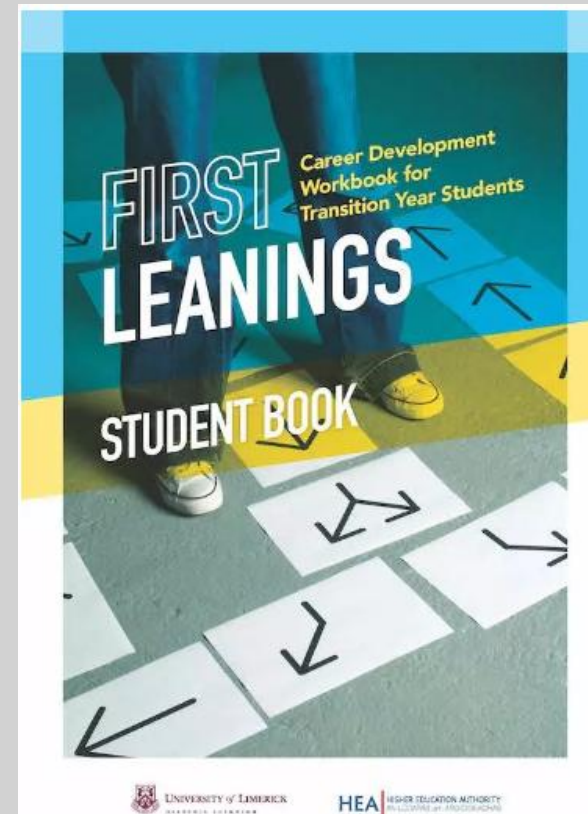

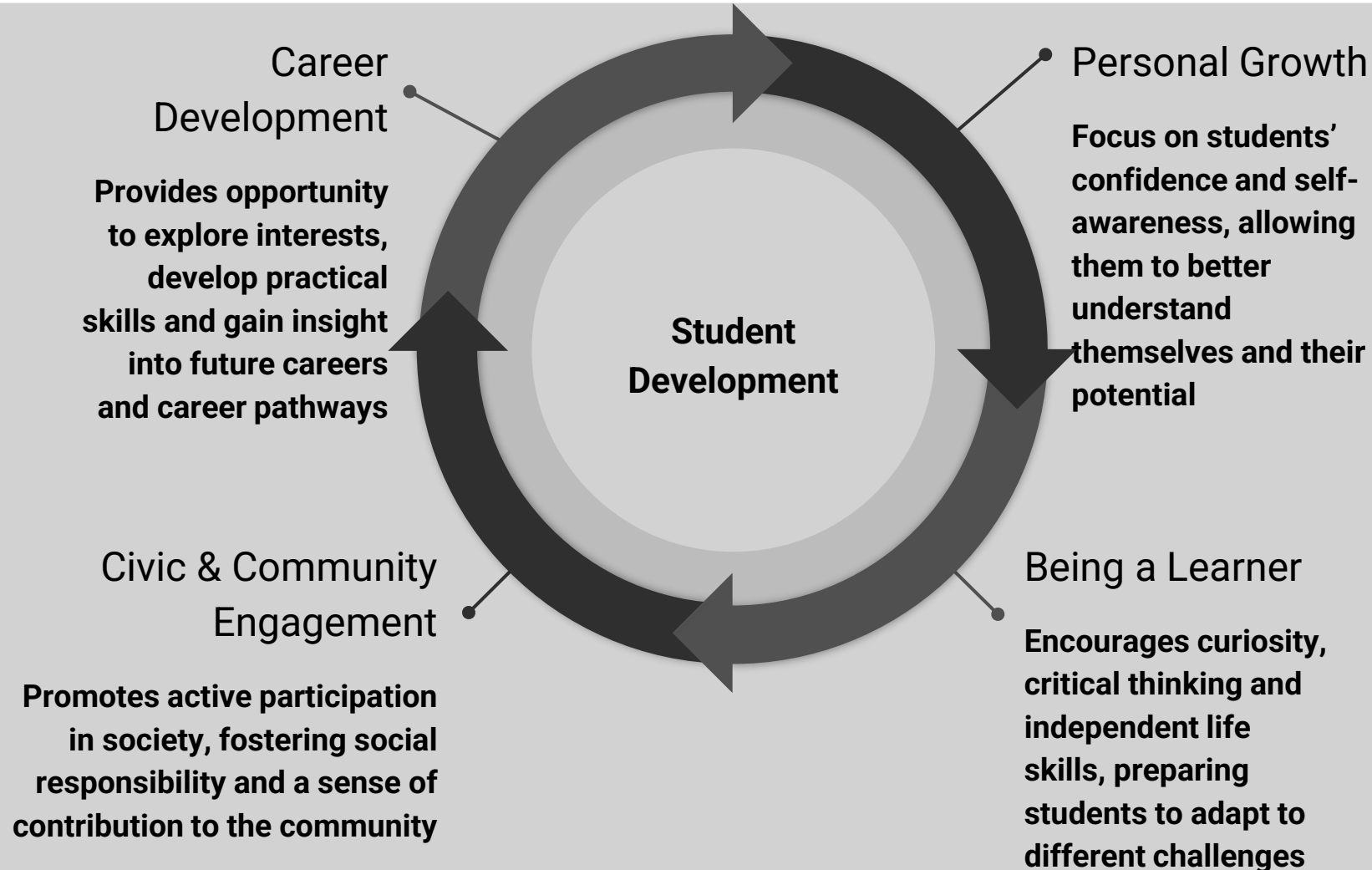

Career Development



- One of the most valuable elements of TY programmes is the opportunity it offers students to take part in Work Experience. This is valuable for a number of reasons:
 - Students can gain a valuable insight into careers of interest (or discover that they don't like a particular career area)
 - They can get an insight into the 'real world' of work
 - They can gain valuable transferable skills
 - They can get the chance to gain experience/references and can gain part-time employment

Work Experience



- Students participate in 3 work experience placements during the year.
- Parents/Guardians are required to use their contacts to find work placement for son/daughter
- Students are encouraged to try a variety of workplaces throughout the year
- Garda vetting may be required
- All students are covered through school insurance
- Students & Parents will be informed of work experience dates in due course

Fifth- & Sixth-Year Students, who had completed T.Y.

- Positive perceptions of TY that remained, a full one or two years after participation, included:
- feelings of increased confidence when trying new things (74%),
- learning how to work as part of a team (68%),
- making a better choice of subjects for the Leaving Certificate than would have been the case without the year out (65%),
- having a stronger idea about what the student wants to do after school (65%),
- acquiring and implementing new organisational and time management skills (53%).





Student Experiences

Petersburg - Overnight Trip

Over the last number of years, TY groups have travelled to Petersburg Outdoor Activity Centre in Co. Galway for a 2 day programme full of activities. It's an opportunity for the group to work on their team building and leadership skills and bond as a group.

Throughout the time spend there they participate in various activities, canoeing, abseiling, an obstacle course and orienteering. There is also a focus was on raft building and testing the assembled raft on the waters of Lough Mask to take them to a nearby island.

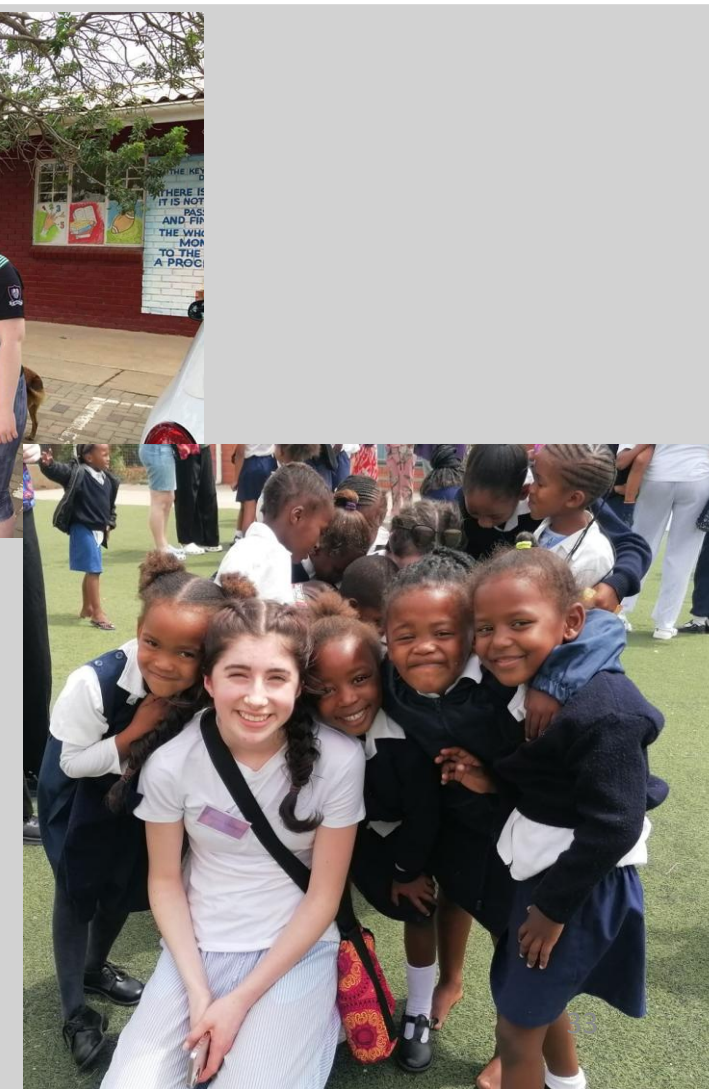
