STATE EXAMINATIONS

As you are well aware, the State Examinations are very close and there are a number of points we want to clarify before the exams commence.

As stated in a previously, normal classes are suspended for all 3rd and 6th year students from Friday 27th of May.

Supervised study will be provided for 3rd and 6th year students from Tuesday 31st to Friday 3rd of June inclusive. (No school on Monday 30th).
